**Service changes/losses in Kaleidoscope**

**Communication & Interaction Team (ASD outreach Advisory Teacher service):** support in inclusive settings providing assessment, advice and intervention for children with ASD. **Moved out of Kaleidoscope July 2012** in order to be co-located at the new specialist school and outreach ASD provision: Drumbeat

**BEST team (Behaviour and Education Support team):** serving children with emotional and behavioural concerns in school, impacting on educational progress – **service was dissolved July 2012**

**Lewisham Information Sharing & Assessment (LISA):** Provision of threshold advice and consultation through our helpdesk; multi-agency training and support on integrated working practice using the information sharing process, Team Around the Child, Lead Professional, **ContactPoint**, the Common Assessment Framework (CAF) and e-CAF. Serving staff across all children and young people services including schools and voluntary and community organisations supporting vulnerable children and children with additional needs – **service was dissolved 2012**

**Information & resource officer / Family Information Service (FIS provided this from 2009):** the funded post of Information Officer ended and in its place, FIS made itself available to parent users of Kaleidoscope through two half-day sessions per week in the resource centre for a time. This provided information and signposting about disability and additional educational needs, service provision and related services for families and staff – **service suspended 2012.**
